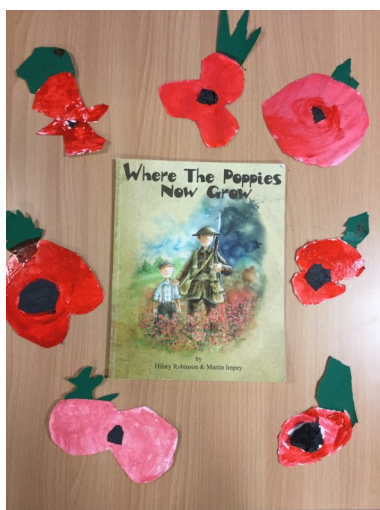
Petition
