Sunnyside Primary Academy — Medium Term integrated Curriculum Autumn Term

TITLE: Transport

YEAR 1

RATIONALE:

In Autumn Term One Year 1 will be learning about transport. They will be comparing modern day transport and transport in the past. They will be taught about events beyond living memory such as the first aeroplane flight. We will visit Sywell Aerodrome and the Sywell museum.

By the end of the unit, all children will understand how transport has changed over the years.

HOOK:

Car wash. Children to wash the teacher's cars.

<u>D&T / Art</u> <u>Collage of transport</u>

I can cut, glue and trim material to create new pictures. I can sort, cut and shape fabrics and experiment with ways of joining them.

Making a boat

I can try out different materials to design and make products.

English

Say sentence then write.

For each mode of transport the children orally rehearse their own sentences and write them.

Instruction writing about how to wash a car

Recount of the trip to Sywell Aerodrome

Then independent write — a fun activity outside.

Look at a model story on train. Children to rehearse the story.

Children to then write a narrative about a train.

History

How were cars different in the past?
How were planes different in the past?
How was transport used in the war?
How were boats different in the past?
How were trains different in the past?
Children to create their own future transport.

SCIENCE

Children will learn about the four seasons. Children to go on an Autumn walk. Collect items and brainstorm adjectives. Children to write about the Autumnal objects. Children will learn how some animals adapt in winter.

HOME LEARNING

Pupils will make a form of transport for the corridor display.

OUTCOME:

Children to reflect at how transport has changed and create a mode of transport for the future.
