Sunnyside Primary Academy — Medium Term Integrated Curriculum Autumn Term Year 1 Go Wild: *Traditional Tales*

Rationale

In the autumn term Year 1 will be reading familiar traditional tales, The Three Little Pigs, Little Red Riding Hood and Three Billy Goats Gruff. The unit will start with the children meeting the Big Bad Wolf. The children will start to question where wild animals live. We are hoping to visit the local woods to see observe nature and perhaps find the wolf! By the end of the unit, children will be able to understand and describe nature and wildlife.

Hook

Art

Create various collages of the woods, trees and wild animal using different textured material

Leaf rubbings to create an Autumn picture.

English

- Character description of the Big Bad wolf.
- A letter from the Three Little Pigs.
- Sequencing Little Red Riding Hood.
- Drama
- Instruction writing for Little Red Riding Hood

Science

- Children learn about the four seasons.
- -Colour in trees according to season change.
- -Children to go on an Autumn walk. Collect items and brainstorm adjectives.
- -Look at different pictures and sort them into the seasons.

<u>Geography</u>

- -Name, locate and identify characteristics of the 4 countries
- Identify seasonal and daily weather patterns in the United Kingdom and the location of hot and cold areas of the world.

Subjects to be taught separately

RE, Computing, PSHE, Music and PE.

Home Learning

Children to create a wolf's habitat.

Outcome

Drama — Each Year 1 class will perform their favourite traditional story.
