




PUPIL PREMIUM



Did you know you may have access to free or subsidised school uniform, clubs and trips?

Are you entitled to Free School Meal / Pupil Premium ?

If you are in receipt of any of the following, your child may be eligible for free school meals and pupil premium.

- * Income Support
- * Income based Job Seekers Allowance
- * Income related Employment and Support Allowance
- * Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- * Child Tax Credit, with no element of Working Tax Credit, and a household income below £16,190 (as assessed by HM Revenue and Customs)
- * Guarantee Element of State Pension Credit
- * Universal Credit - income dependant

What is Pupil Premium?

Pupil Premium funding is additional funding allocated to all schools to support disadvantaged pupils. Sunnyside Primary Academy receives pupil premium for: children that are cared for or adopted from care; children whose parents are in the armed forces; and for every pupil who has received free (benefit related) school meals over the past 6 years. This funding is allocated to the school on the basis of the number of children who are eligible for Pupil Premium assistance.

It can only be awarded to pupils only if their parents have applied.
