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
Mr Gale's Garden

Mr Gale nodded. "Maybe they will win us a prize."








Jake and Mr Gale planted the seeds in the ground.


Each day, Jake came to water the seeds. Then, one morning...

beans bopping...




and sweetcorn singing.

peas popping...




and leeks leaping.

- Plant some seeds in some pots or in your garden. Remember to water them and watch them grow!


